Voting Structure

The Pacific Coast Shipbuilders Association has two voting membership categories, the first is a Shipyard Member; the second is the Industry Member. The Shipyard Membership category represents 60% of the voting total while the Industry Membership category represents the remaining 40% of the vote.

There are three levels of membership. Please select a level from the list below:

Shipyard Member – (Voting Member) Shipyard members are companies that are well established in British Columbia and are the primary providers of repairs, maintenance and new construction of vessels. These companies are able to drydock vessels as well perform repairs and modifications afloat, alongside their facilities.

Annual Membership Fee - \$4000

Industrial Member – (Voting Member) Any firm or corporation who does not qualify for shipyard membership but is established business in British Columbia that is engaged in a trade, business or occupation which relates to or is involved in the rendering of services to the shipbuilding, ship repair, offshore and/or associated marine industries. This may include fabricators, unions, suppliers, Naval Architects, etc.

Annual Membership Fee - \$1000

Associate Industry Member – (Non Voting Member) Any firm or organization established in British Columbia that supports the shipbuilding, ship repair, offshore and /or associated marine industries. This may include municipalities, educational facilities, etc.
